

# Journey the Camino Via de la Plata with Desert Odyssey Passage II

April 22 - May, 2 2025



The Vía de la Plata, or the Ruta de la Plata, is one of the longest Camino routes spanning about 1,000km and crosses natural reserves with a wealth of cultural and ecological heritage. The term “Via de la Plata” (closely translating to “Silver Way”) has its roots in the original etymological meaning from the Arabic “Bal’latta”. This last 138.4km distance of the Vía de la Plata is probably the most beautiful of all the ‘last 100km’ to Santiago de Compostela.

The Vía de la Plata is known for its quietness, which also adds to its charm and tranquillity, a fantastic option for pilgrims who want open landscapes and time to reflect. The expansive countryside becomes your constant companion in the Vía de la Plata.

A map of the route is shown above. Closer to the date of your Camino, the final route will be determined based on logistics, weather, amenities and other factors.

Walking distances are based on a walking speed of about 4km/hour and distances vary by about 10-15%.

Average temperature in April is between 10°C and 20°C; low rain season; 12 hours of daylight.

An indicative schedule of the first three and last two days is shown above.
