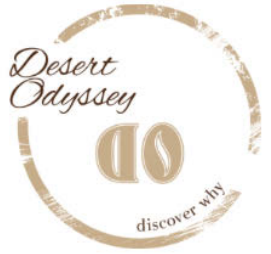


# Journey with Desert Odyssey
