Embark on a life-transforming journey of 123 kilometers with a small group of fellow peregrinos (pilgrims) on the Camino Primitivo or the Original Way. The name "Primitivo" refers to its origin as the first Camino de Santiago ever walked. Its history dates back to the 9th century when Spanish King Alfonso II walked to Santiago de Compostela. According to the legend, he completed the Camino to commemorate the discovery of the remains of St. James the Apostle in Compostela. The Camino Primitivo is the closest to the origins of the pilgrimage route, as it is mostly in natural settings, making it one of the most intimate and scenic routes. The Roman city walls in Lugo is a Unesco World Heritage site and is the only one in the world with their perimeter still intact.



Single Occupancy: S\$5,350
