Step onto the historic Camino Portugués and experience the magic of the Camino de Santiago on this unforgettable 118km pilgrimage from Tui. The Central Route of the Camino Portugués from Tui to Santiago is one of the most rewarding and historic walking trails in Europe. 2027 is special because it is the holy year Xacobeo, making it an extraordinary time to embark on this journey. Together with a small group of fellow peregrinos, you'll wander through the green landscapes of Galicia, pass through enchanting medieval towns, and follow ancient Roman paths that have guided pilgrims for centuries. More than just a walk, the Camino is a deeply enriching journey of reflection, friendship, culture, and personal discovery – all culminating in the iconic city of Santiago de Compostela.



Single Occupancy: S\$5,350

The cost covers accommodations, meals, transportation (start point transfer), luggage transfers during the Camino, Compostela (credentials), Camino Passport, Peregrino's Shell, programme and material.

Twin Occupancy: S\$4,650

Twin share is available subject to your having a roommate or someone else requesting for one.

The programme fee does not include your airfare or airport transfers.

Closer to the date of your Camino, the final route will be determined based on logistics, weather, amenities and other factors. Walking distances are based on a walking speed of about 4km/hour. Average temperature in April is between 12°C and 20°C; low rain season; 12 hours of daylight
