

# Journey with Desert Odyssey on the Via de la Plata

The Via de la Plata, or the Ruta de la Plata, is one of the longest Camino routes spanning about 1,000km and crosses natural reserves with a wealth of cultural and ecological heritage. The term "Via de la Plata" (closely translating to "Silver Way") has its roots in the original etymological meaning from the Arabic "Bal'latta". This last 138.4km distance of the Via de la Plata is probably the most beautiful of all the 'last 100km' to Santiago de Compostela, making it the perfect choice to walk in 2027, which marks a special Xacobeo Holy Year.



## Single Occupancy: S\$5,350

The cost covers accommodations, meals, transportation (start point transfer), luggage transfers during the Camino, Compostela (credentials), Camino Passport, Peregrino's Shell, programme and material.

## Twin Occupancy: S\$4,650

Twin share is available subject to your having a roommate or someone else requesting for one.

The programme fee does not include your airfare or airport transfers.
