Starting in the historic Atlantic port city of Ferrol, renowned for its 18th-century naval heritage and located approximately 113.5 kilometres north of Santiago de Compostela - the Camino Inglés leads travelers into a captivating world of natural wonder. Leaving coastal estuaries behind, the route climbs into Galicia's soul-stirring heart, where moss-strewn paths wind through towering eucalyptus groves, ancient oak forests, and emerald rolling hills. Fragrant woodlands, quiet rivers, and timeless stone hamlets create an enchanting tapestry of solitude and beauty, offering a deeply rewarding journey through nature before reaching the sacred spires of Santiago. Adding to the magic, 2027 marks a special Xacobeo (Compostelan Holy Year) - a rare event when the Cathedral's ceremonial Holy Door opens, filling the entire route with a celebratory spirit and a sense of shared pilgrimage.



Single Occupancy: S\$5,350

The cost covers accommodations, meals, transportation (start point transfer), luggage transfers during the Camino, Compostela (credentials), Camino Passport, Peregrino's Shell, programme and material.

Twin Occupancy: S\$4,650

Twin share is available subject to your having a roommate or someone else requesting for one.

The programme fee does not include your airfare or airport transfers.

Average temperature in September is between 12°C and 20°C; low rain season; 12 hours of daylight
